Hello Bret:

You are correct that we are well below the market with our rental rates. The benefit of that is long-term tenants, less demanding tenants, no vacancies, and no staff time needed to recruit/screen prospective tenants.

Our pattern now is to increase rent \$50 per month each January 1.

There is a benevolence element for the one family with the autistic son. His ability to live in the Ladue school district has been a wonderful blessing according to that family. I'm not sure when he is due to graduate. Our properties are reasonably solid, but they are not in top dollar condition, either.

I have wondered about the practical benefits of hiring a property management firm for the two rentals. They would get a fee and would push the rentals toward the market rates, and they would deal with keeping them occupied. I don't know any specifics on the costs and specific duties.

I am open to putting this on the agenda for our next Finance Committee meeting scheduled for 7/30.

Admin Elders,

I think we are charging well below market for the two rental homes, maybe by as much as \$500,00/month each.

My daughter recently shopped for rental homes in the Kansas City area. For a similar home she could not find anything for less that \$1,800.00/month. Our rental homes are also in the very attractive Ladue school district.

Zillo rental estimates:

- 1346 N. Rock Hill <u>\$1,849.00/month</u>
- 1356 N. Rock Hill \$2,364.00/month

I do not expect us to pursue top dollar but we should expect market rate for our rental investment. There may be some consideration of benevolence but we are looking at about \$6,000.00 per tenant, or a total of \$12,000. That is a lot of benevolence. If we did not have the houses but the equivalent funds in the bank and someone came to the church asking for help, would we be willing to give two strangers \$6,000/year for multiple years? Remember, as rental property they also consume administrative overhead, with Tom Hunsaker required to periodically review property and maintain.

My recommendation would be to inform the tenants that we plan to increase rates substantially. If they find it excessive they can shop for a better rate (which they won't find). If they decide to vacate we can sell the property (I'd like to sell the 1346 property) or find new tenants, but at a much higher rate, closer to market. Again, we are leaving about \$12,000.00/year on the table.

This is an area I think we need to revisit periodically and wanting to get on your radar again.
