#### c. What do we Believe?

This draft document – <u>What Do We Believe</u> (for elders only and not to be published) - is Bret's attempt to document key decisions made over the years in various elder meetings as well as from several key documents, such as the <u>MX Welcome Packet</u>, <u>MX Core Beliefs</u>, <u>MX 2014</u> <u>Gender Study</u>, and other items on the MX website (<u>https://www.mxchurch.org/</u>).

This draft document categorizes beliefs into essential and non-essential practices, and highlighted the need for clarity on these beliefs as the congregation considers hiring a new minister. The discussion included various topics such as women's roles in ministry and the interpretation of scriptural qualifications for elders.

\* Note: the document on "What do we believe" is draft and only for the elders and is not intended to be shared publicly.

## d. Passing Communion and Collection Trays

Reviewing the process used each Sunday to pick-up communion and take collection. Considering the following:

- Communion provide holders for cups on the backs of pews. Cups can then be picked up after service and avoid passing trays during service to collect.
- Collection children put contribution in box at from of auditorium and everyone else put contribution and any prayer requests in collection box by door existing auditorium. Will start with the one current box and if additional boxes are needed will address later.
