Dear Safety Team,

We have recently updated the security cameras at the McKnight church building, so this is a good time to share an overview of the system and review our Sunday and event procedures.

## Camera Deployment

For several years, we have used a Wi-Fi–based camera system. This system has worked well but can occasionally experience lag or brief display glitches. To complement the Wi-Fi cameras, we have now added several **hard-wired cameras** with advanced AI detection features, which provide a more reliable, real-time view of the building’s exterior and key interior areas.

Together, the wired and wireless systems give us broad real-time coverage of public spaces throughout the building. **No cameras are installed in private areas** such as bathrooms, prayer rooms, or offices. Cameras serve as both a monitoring tool and a visible deterrent, helping reduce the need for constant patrols. Notices are posted at entrances to inform visitors that cameras are in use.

## Sunday and Event Coverage

Even with improved visibility, we will continue to have **at least two Safety Team members on duty** during Sunday worship and during special events such as VBS, Trunk-or-Treat, Worship at the Park, and other large gatherings.

Team members on duty should maintain radio contact.

- The individual monitoring cameras may need to direct another team member to a specific area.
- Any situation should be handled as a **team**, not by one person alone.
- Our church is private property, and we may politely deny access or ask anyone to leave if needed.
- Always remain calm and respectful. Seek to **de-escalate** when possible and **call the police immediately** if a situation poses risk.

Visible Safety Team members, especially those using two-way radios, serve as an important deterrent to unwanted behavior.

## Sunday Presence and Conduct

During Sunday worship, Safety Team members should be present in **high-traffic areas**—the main foyer and first-floor hallways—before and after service and when children are dismissed for classes (after Communion).

Please also help maintain a safe and welcoming environment by reminding children **not to run in the hallways** and by being **friendly, approachable, and attentive** to visitors. The Safety Team represents

McKnight Crossings not only as protectors but also as **ambassadors** of our church’s hospitality and care.

Thank you for your continued service in keeping McKnight safe, calm, and welcoming for everyone.
