Mentoring and Discipleship

- Discussion emphasized intentional mentoring of emerging leaders, recognizing that growth may involve imperfections and learning opportunities.
- The group agreed that spiritual development requires both patience and structure for discipleship.
- Example: Bryant Taylor has assumed more leadership in Sunday worship since Jeremy Picker's departure. While showing growth and maturity, Bryant would benefit from consistent mentoring.
 - Action: Steve Awtrey will meet with Bryant regularly to provide guidance and mentoring in his worship leadership role.

<u>Dave Weiler</u> noted that if Eric begins sitting in with the elders, it would represent a new precedent for our faith tradition (Churches of Christ). He compared it to Jackie Robinson's grace and courage in breaking new ground—encouraging Eric to respond to possible criticism with peace and dignity.

<u>Bret</u> added that as elders, we must discern not only what is *scripturally permissible* but also what is *spiritually beneficial*.

"As with science, just because we can do something doesn't mean we should. We must weigh
congregational impact and prayerfully decide which issues are worth pressing forward on (is this a
hill we are willing to die on)."
