1. Devotional

Reviewed the Leadership Training we had Feb. 8.

2. People

3. Lead Minister (LM) Candidates – summary document <u>here</u>

- **John Blackmore** (completed 2nd Zoom 2/03/2025) Discussed having John come in to pray with the elders and preach/teach. When John preaches, we would like feedback from the congregation but especially from Matthew Bardowell, Eric McPherson, and Jason Vincent.
 - <u>Dave Weiler</u> to prepare salary and benefits information for John Blackmore before any next steps to make sure financial expectations are aligned.
- Chris Jackson (upcoming Zoom 1/30/2025) Majority feel Chris is worth a second Zoom interview.

<u>LM Website/Flyer</u> – Jeff McGlawn and Steve Walker to work on this, using the Children's Minister website/flyer as a template.

4. Children's and Family Minister

5. Preaching Schedule

Waiting for Steve Awtrey to discuss at next meeting. As noted in Eric McPherson's letter (on-line <u>here</u>), it would be preferable to have a standing preaching rotation, possibly have Eric McPherson, Jeff Kryder, Matthew Bardowell rotate each month and fill in extra weeks with other individuals. (May need a separate Zoom meeting to discuss a standing preaching rotation)

6. Children's Ministry Intern

Considering if Izzy Hennigan would be a good intern this summer. Before pursuing we need to understand Izzy's plans for this summer. As this is her senior year it is important that Izzy be able to attend her family reunion and Ne-O-Tez functions. If an internship does not conflict with any of these plans it would be good to have Izzy assist.

Also, Jeff McGlawn will be out of the country (in Hungary) for most of June 2025.



7. Tuition Assistance

Nathan has started classes in Practical Ministry at Abilene Christian University (course information *here*). Here is my understanding of what we agreed upon during our discussion:

- 1. This was a one-time special request for Nathan, and we are not ready to establish this as policy (as most voiced opposition to it).
- 2. This opportunity is considered highly beneficial for Nathan at a great price, making the decision a "no-brainer." The Elders agreed to support his tuition reimbursement request.
- 3. Tuition will be reimbursed at the end of the class, provided Nathan receives a grade of "B" or higher. He must submit both his grades and the class receipt for reimbursement.
- 4. Tuition reimbursement is contingent on Nathan continuing to work at McKnight for three years after graduation. If he leaves before that period, the funds must be repaid.

8. Collection Process

To streamline the Sunday service and minimize confusion and some awkwardness passing the collection plates, it is recommended to stop passing the collection. Instead, it is recommended that we announce during service that the children can come forward and put their contribution in the box and that anyone else who does not contribute on-line can put their contribution (and any prayer requests) in the box at the back of the auditorium. It was decided that the contribution box in the foyer should be made non-subtle to make sure it can easily be found.

After implementation we will continue to monitor the new process and adapt as needed.

We will start the new collection process next Sunday, February 16, 2025. After the communion thought, during the normal time for collection prayer, an elder should make an announcement about the change with the collection.

<u>Passing Communion</u> – after we start the new collection process outlined above, the plan is to only pass trays for the communion once. We will pass out the bread and juice cups and will not later pass out trays to pick them up. Instead, Don Fitzgerald and Steve Awtrey will drill cup holes in the pew cadies to hold the used communion items (<u>example template</u>). These will be picked up after service.

iii. Update Document on Women's Roles

Someone should take the lead on updating this document to make it more applicable to the current worship at McKnight. e. What do we Believe?

This draft document – <u>What Do We Believe</u> (for elders only and not to be published) - is Bret's attempt to document key decisions made over the years in various elder meetings as well as from several key documents, such as the <u>MX Welcome Packet</u>, <u>MX Core Beliefs</u>, <u>MX 2014 Gender Study</u>, and other items on the MX website (<u>https://www.mxchurch.org/</u>).

This draft document categorizes beliefs into essential and non-essential practices, and highlighted the need for clarity on these beliefs as the congregation considers hiring a new minister. The discussion included various topics such as women's roles in ministry and the interpretation of scriptural qualifications for elders.
