3. Kaelble's for Unity in Diversity (UiD)

Steve Walker has approached Alan and Suzanne Kaelble to restart this ministry. All elders except Bret supported restarting this ministry. Bret feels it best to let this ministry go fallow (more detail on concerns noted on-line <u>here</u>).

Alan and Suzanne Kaelble met with the elders to discuss their thoughts on the ministry. Note: The Kaelble's have been involved in many ministries dealing with the outcast and marginalized, such as: Christian Family Services (CFS), racial reconciliation (Suzanne more so than Allan), prison ministry and reform, Room at the Inn.

- Summary of discussion between Steve Walker and the Kaelble's <u>here</u>.
- The Kaelbles expressed some reluctance about formally leading a ministry but are open to hosting occasional "field trips" to places like Crown Candy and East St. Louis.
- Kaelble's would narrow Unity in Diversity to be primarily an exploration of the African American experience, mostly here in St. Louis.
- MX currently has a racially diverse and welcoming congregation.
- Suzanne is aware that UiD can be sensitive and may risk alienating some members unnecessarily.

 Use this as a starting point for a monthlong class on eldership. Will just have this one class on Sundays to maximize attendance. Will talk about the qualifications of an elder and note that "Husband of but one wife" does not mean divorce excludes eligibility for eldership.

- b. Possible men: Bardowell, Kryder, Sewkarran, McPherson, Fuller, Eikle Of the above the following were removed:
 - Kryder best to give new minister Andrew Owens at least a year before Jeff Kryder starts as an elder. Want to Give Andrew space to find his own voice.
 - Sewkarran a good man but needs more opportunities to lead. Possibly in Small Groups
 - Fuller Chris has not raised young children but adopted a teenage daughter.
 - We will approach the other men to see if they are interested to sit alongside the elders for a time to understand expectations.

9. MX Parking Lot Issues

Although MX has signage stating that trucks and trailers are not allowed on our parking lots we still get occasional trucks parking or turning around in our lot. This is problematic as these heavy trucks can do serious damage to our asphalt parking surface. We discussed ways to prevent trucks and trailers from using the lot.

- We have been using safety cones to block the far south exit/entrance to the parking lot since it was sealed over a year ago. This has drastically cut down on large trucks using the lot.
- Considering adding additional cones and barriers to make it even more difficult for trucks to use our lot for turning. These cones and barriers will be moved for Sunday service.
 - Elders agreed to implement the above. It is the quickest, easiest, and cheapest of the alternatives discussed.

What is the plan for the student ministry staff and volunteers when a teenager comes out or expresses samesex attraction?

How do you love and support LGBT teenagers who are in your church?

Does your church have a plan to support parents whose kids have come out when the parents are unsure of how to respond?

What happens when someone involved in your church comes out and sees no contradiction between homosexuality and God's laws in Scripture?

Is your church a place where someone who has been in the LGBT community (but is currently not) can attend and be involved?

Would your church be open to having dialogue with people from the LGBT community who aren't in your church?

How does your pastor address LGBT issues in sermons?

What if a lesbian wanted to be baptized?

Could an openly gay man join your church as a member?

What would your staff do if an LGBT couple came to your church wanting to be married?

What would the reaction be if member had a sex change and still attended your church?
